- ◇ Free electronic breast pump.
- ◇ Two weeks of home-delivered customized/medically tailored meals for pregnant members on bed rest or after delivery.
- ◇ Ten weeks of home-delivered medically tailored meals for pregnant members with gestational diabetes.
- ◇ Members who are new mothers (up to 12 months) and children up to age 5 years are eligible for a bus pass, \$50 gas card, or \$50 Uber card for transportation.
- ◇ Baby Essentials Bundle Package available for pregnant or new moms, and babies up to 12 months old.
- ◇ Pregnant members or postpartum members (up to 12 months) are eligible for a \$200 gift card to purchase baby essentials such as strollers, diapers, etc.

- ◇ Free electronic breast pump.
- ◇ Pregnancy case management services offering instruction and guidance during pregnancy, postpartum, and early childhood.
- ◇ Breastfeeding instruction with a certified lactation consultant.
- ◇ Tummy2Family app offers pregnancy and parenting support.
- ◇ Healthy pregnancy and postpartum rewards.
- ◇ Diapers for Quitters– Diapers for pregnant mothers who complete smoking cessation class.
- ◇ Baby Showers, which include education and rewards.
- ◇ Wellhop for mom and baby– connect with other moms through group video support.

- ◇ Free electronic breast pump.
- ◇ Free car seat/booster seat for timely prenatal appointment attendance.
- ◇ \$75 gift card for attending postpartum appointment.
- ◇ Home-delivered meals to support nutritional needs during pregnancy and postpartum.
- ◇ Transportation to resources, such as food banks, job interviews, training, or health appointments. May include children/ family; prior authorization required.
- ◇ Annual Molina baby showers for members which includes \$100 gift card for attendees.

- ◇ Free electronic breast pump.
- ◇ Baby Welcome Kit and Bundle gifts free to case management enrollees.
- ◇ Baby Showers, which include free necessities, immunizations, education classes, parenting resources, etc.
- ◇ Specialized case manager to help with the entire pregnancy experience.
- ◇ Referrals to Baby’s Bounty for diapers and baby items.
- ◇ Transportation during pregnancy and postpartum for appointments.
- ◇ Behavioral Health support through Novum Behavioral Health.
- ◇ Employment, housing and utility resources available upon request for qualified members.
